The Handlers' Racing Association, dba Bremerton Raceway is proud to bring drag racing to Kitsap County at the inactive runway of the Bremerton International Airport for the 59<sup>th</sup> consecutive year.

The Bremerton Raceway 2018 race season will officially start Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup> when the gates open at 3 pm for Street Legals and a Test & Tune for all vehicles. Racing starts at 4 pm until dusk. The gates will close at 9 pm. Tech cards are \$25 for car and driver. General admission is \$5 for adults, children 5 and under are free. Unless you have a current NHRA number and membership, you will purchase a Bremerton Raceway number for \$10 when you purchase your tech card at the gate. That number will be good for the entire 2018 race season. Each time you race at Bremerton, you will be ask to show your number card at the gate and in tech.

Saturday, March 31<sup>st</sup> will be a Test and Tune for all vehicles. Tech cards (car & driver) are \$45. A cash bash will be run in the afternoon. Gates open at 8 am, racing starts at 9 am, The gates will close at 8 pm.

Sunday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, the gates open at 8 am for our Easter Bunny National/Mike Sarver Memorial race/Summit E.T., Junior Dragster and Junior Street Series #1. This is the first Team Bremerton point's race of the 2018 season. The E.T. Finals are in Boise, Idaho this year, so sign up at the gate and start accumulating your points. Tech cards (car & driver) are \$45 for Sportsman and Motorcycle, \$55 for Pro, \$60 for Super Pro, \$25 for High School and \$35 for Junior Dragsters and Junior Street. General admission is \$12 for adults, \$10 for Active Duty Military, children 6-12 are \$5, 5 and under are free. Gates open at 8 am, racing starts at 9 am.
