Hi. Dennis Boley here to talk a little.

Time for some new thoughts.

On the schedule the July 20th race is listed as "Race to Save". That day it will be a non points bracket race. Same payout schedule and all the other classes listed will race.

We are now officially the BREMERTON BOMBERS. I talked to quite a few racers, and got their input, and this is what the consensus wanted. A new logo is being worked on. It will be something containing World War II designs that could be found on the bombers of that era. The track colors are red, white, and blue.

Let's talk about reserved pit spots. If a pit spot number is painted in orange, that pit spot has been paid for by a racer. That pit spot is the racers from Friday to Sunday. If you get to the track early on Friday and do not have a reserved pit spot, do not park in one that has an orange number. If you are not sure, check at the gate, there will be an up to date list located there. In addition, when parking, remember the white lines are the boundaries of your pit spot. Do not park any of your equipment outside those boundaries. If you need more space, I recommend next year buy more than one spot. And last, but not least, pick up your trash before you leave. The facility must be clean when I leave on Sunday night. I do not relish picking up other people's garbage, but if you leave it on the ground, I have to. There are plenty of garbage cans located on the facility, if you can't find one, let a staff member know, and we will get one for you.

Garbage includes, but is not limited to, dog poop, soda cans, soda bottle, cigarette butts, paper, etc.

One more item, courtesy staging is in effect at Bremerton Raceway. That means both pre-stage lights should be on, prior to either stage light. Let's be courteous to all racers.

On a positive note, I think car counts have been great. Thanks to all who keep supporting Bremerton Raceway. I will continue my efforts to provide a safe and happy place to race.
